



## Players Code of Conduct

- Respect the Golden Rule: Treat your teammates, coaches, opposing players, parents and officials in the same manner you want to be treated. This means no yelling, no sarcasm, and no embarrassing anyone in front of others. To gain respect, you must give respect.
- Metro Courts is a practice facility. While you are here, commit to working hard, focus on improving your game, encourage your teammates, and most importantly, keep in mind that participation in sports is supposed to be fun.
- Play safe, act safe...just be safe.
- NO slam dunking; NO shots from half court; please don't make us remind you.
- Don't arrive more than (15) minutes before your scheduled class or practice time. If you arrive within those (15) minutes, do not interrupt or draw attention away from the teams and players on the court.
- When you participate in a class or practice on the court, consider yourself in school. Coaches and instructors are here to teach you the fundamentals of the game. They should not be distracted by your behavior or your attitude.
- You are here to play, so put your phone away! A charging area is provided in the front sitting area...that will act as a parking lot for electronics if "out".
- No pictures or videos may be taken of other teams' training sessions or practices.
- We are not responsible for lost or stolen items. If you worry about an item of value disappearing, leave it at home. There is nowhere to lock up your valuables. ***Always place your belongings in the cubbies located at center court.***
- Avoid swearing, abusive language and irresponsible behavior.
- Refrain from using alcohol, tobacco products or illegal substances.
- If you as an individual or your team intentionally damage or deface any portion of Metro Courts, Inc., you will be asked to leave and not return to our facility.
